

1. Determine eligibility (see below)

2A. **OZH clinic:** Enter electronic “Request for MCA” order in Expanse and complete requirements

2B. **OZH ED discharge:** Enter electronic order in AMBULATORY ORDERS on Discharge Tab, “Request for MCA” and complete requirements

2C. **Non-OZH Facility:** Write prescription or paper order for monoclonal antibody infusion (MCA), including diagnosis of COVID-19 AND date of symptom onset

3. **ALL Facilities:** FAX positive test result (if NOT viewable in Expanse) to OZH Central Scheduling at 417-257-5905. WE MUST HAVE TEST RESULT to schedule. Non-OZH facilities *also* fax order.

4. Scheduling will contact patient for appointment scheduling

5. If need in less than 24 hours to meet 10-day deadline for giving, call scheduling to see how we may best accommodate the request. We will make every effort to address every patients needs with the resources currently available.

****CRITERIA for ELIGIBILITY now allow for provider to determine individual patient risk for progressing to severe disease based on medical and socioeconomic factors (many of our patients)****

Consider treatment if yes to all below:

1. Age \geq 12 years
2. Weight \geq 40kg or 88lbs
3. Symptom onset <10 days ago
4. NOT hospitalized for COVID
5. NOT requiring oxygen therapy due to COVID-19, OR
6. NOT requiring an increase in base-line oxygen therapy due to COVID-19 for those on chronic oxygen.

AND has ONE of the following:

- Any medical condition or other factor, including race or ethnicity, that puts you at higher risk of progression to severe COVID-19
- Age \geq 65 years of age
- Obesity or being overweight
- Pregnancy
- Chronic kidney disease
- Diabetes
- Immunosuppressive disease or immunosuppressive treatment
- Cardiovascular disease or hypertension
- Chronic lung diseases
- Sickle cell disease
- Neurodevelopmental disorders
- Having a medical-related technological dependence (for example: tracheostomy gastrostomy, or positive pressure ventilation not related to COVID-19)

Appointments are being scheduled 7am-1pm, 7 days per week. Location on main campus & times may vary depending on community needs. Nursing staff will confirm patients are still maintaining appropriate oxygen saturations before administration. We will stay informed of changes to EUAs and adjust specific monoclonal antibody used based on FDA guidance.
