



## How to schedule your patient for monoclonal antibody

1. Determine eligibility
2. Write prescription or paper order including Diagnosis of COVID-19 AND date of symptom onset
3. FAX script/order AND positive test result (if NOT done at Ozarks Healthcare (OZH) to OZH Central Scheduling at 417-257-5905.
4. Scheduling will contact patient with appointment information.

**\*\*CRITERIA for ELIGIBILITY now allow for provider to determine individual patient risk for progressing to severe disease based on medical and socioeconomic factors\*\***

Patients are NOT eligible for treatment if:

1. Age less than 12 years
2. Weight less than 40kg or 88lbs
3. Symptom onset more than 10 days ago
4. Hospitalized for COVID-19
5. Require oxygen therapy due to COVID-19, OR
6. Require and increase in baseline oxygen therapy due to COVID-19 for those on chronic oxygen.

### Eligibility criteria as of 5/14/2021:

- Any medical condition or other factor, including race or ethnicity, that puts you at higher risk of progression to severe COVID-19
- Age  $\geq$  65 years of age
- Obesity or being overweight
- Pregnancy
- Chronic kidney disease
- Diabetes
- Immunosuppressive disease or immunosuppressive treatment
- Cardiovascular disease or hypertension
- Chronic lung diseases
- Sickle cell disease
- Neurodevelopmental disorders
- Having a medical-related technological dependence (for example: tracheostomy gastrostomy, or positive pressure ventilation not related to COVID-19)

Appointments are currently being scheduled to start at 6am in the ED with up to 4 patients being scheduled daily. We are monitoring need to expand service and scheduling will communicate any changes to patients. Nursing staff will confirm patients are still maintaining appropriate oxygen saturations before administration. Pharmacy and incident command stay informed of changes to FDA EUAs for monoclonal antibodies and adjust specific monoclonal antibody administered based on this guidance.
