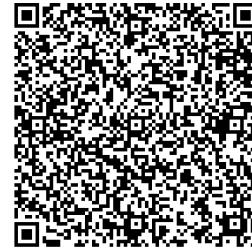

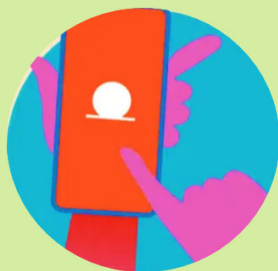

Earned Wages Access



No more waiting for payday!

- Earned Wage Access is a financial service that allows coworkers to access a portion of earned wages before the scheduled payday.
- This On Demand Pay service is designed to help coworkers manage unexpected expenses and reduce financial stress by avoiding high-interest loans.
- A coworker can request funds through the Pay widget in Paylocity Employee Self Service/Home or the Paylocity Mobile App, which are then deposited into that coworker's direct deposit account.
- The deposit occurs the same day if requested prior to 2:00 PM Central Time. Otherwise, the deposit will occur the next business day.
- All salaried employees, as well as all hourly employees that log hours into Paylocity's Time & Labor system are eligible to EWA.
